Alliance courses are fun and effective! Emphasis is on speaking and listening skills. Teachers are native French speakers.

Maximum class size is ten. New students may join at any time. Their fee is prorated to the number of classes remaining. A minimum of six students is required to constitute a class. An existing class of four or five may continue if students agree to pay an additional fee, or decrease the number of classes. Private instruction is available at \$42 per hour.

If the class you choose is full, or if the Alliance Française must cancel a class because of insufficient enrollment, we will contact you about registering in another course. We will give you a full refund if you do not select an alternative. If you register in a class and drop it before classes start, your registration fee will be refunded, minus a \$15 administrative fee. After the first class meeting, there will be no refund if you decide to drop the class. Please be aware that some classes fill quickly, so to assure a place, you should make payment early.

Course Descriptions

General French:

- A1:** for true beginners (*Reflets* 1, video)
A1+: for beginners who have been exposed to French in the past (*Reflets* 1, video)
A2: continuation of A1 (*Reflets* 1, video)
A2+: continuation of A1+
A3: continuation of A2 (*Reflets* 1, video)
A4: continuation of A3 (*Reflets* 1, video)
A4+: slightly higher level than A4
B2+: intermediate level (*Reflets* 1, video)
C1: advanced intermediate level (*Reflets* 2, video)

French Review I and II:

Accelerated review of Beginning to Advanced levels (with *Reflets* and video)

Grammar Review:

Review of French grammar from A to Z.

Conversation:

Advanced Beginner: general conversation, with video

Intermediate: conversation based on newspaper articles, or with video

Advanced: topics chosen by students and suggested by instructor

Advanced (littérature): reading of two literary works, including a play

Travel French: beginner – practical situations – "Survival French"

Régions de France: Discovery of various French regions: history, geography, culture, sites, gastronomy, etc.
